### LOT 1096

A pair of Chinese blue and white crackle glazed porcelain vases and covers, mark of Kangxi but late 19th/early 20th century, each baluster body painted with dragons amidst peony, underglaze blue four-character mark to bases, height 27.5cm (one with repair to neck), together with a Chinese Canton famille rose vase, mid to late 19th century, painted with figures, flowers and birds, height 25.2cm (reduced neck).

### Condition Report

1096. Blue and white vase and cover 1 - vase is in good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and typical light discolouration to the crackle of glaze. Cover with small rim repair, otherwise ok.

Blue and white vase and cover 2 - two small 'U' shaped sections of rim broken and re-glued (approx 3cm x 1.5cm and 2.5cm x 1.5cm). Otherwise the rest of the body is in generally good condition. Typical light surface scratches and typical light discolouration to crackle of glaze. Cover with re-glued finial, otherwise ok.

Canton vase - reduced neck, 7cm vertical crack to body and typical wear to gilt and enamels. Small chip to footrim.
