1177. Both with typical surface scratches and wear. Both repaired areas with visible glue residue.

Vase 1 - neck broken and re-glued where it meets the body. Bulb mouth with chips to rim and repaired. Body in good condition.

Vase 2 - blub mouth has been broken and repaired with some minor chips/losses along breaks. One of the apertured to the body has a small re-glued section of rim and a chip to the same rim. Otherwise body is in good condition.
