1047. The figure is in generally good condition, but does have some pale blue/green verdegris-type build-up across the face and body of the figure. Otherwise no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear to gilt, more pronounced on high points. Casting and decoration good and crisp. Blue pigmentation visible to hair.
