1057. 1057. Large vajra ♦ generally good condition commensurate with age. Typical surface scratches and wear to patination. Some nicks and dents to prongs of the crown, but no significant damage or repairs.

Mid size vajra ♦ generally good condition with typical surface scratches and wear, but no significant damage or repairs.  
Weight 143.3g.

Small vajra ♦ generally good condition with typical surface scratches and wear, but no significant damage or repairs.  
Weight 24.9g.
