A Chinese carved agate figure of a standing maiden, late 20th century, height 15.2cm (neck repaired), and a Chinese grey agate lotus pod and leafy tendril carving, on a wire inlaid wood stand, total height 14.5cm, together with a pair of Chinese glass quail boxes and covers, length 7cm, with wood stands, and a glass figure of a maiden with wire inlaid wood stand, total height 13.7cm.

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

1188, Agate lady - broken and reglued across neck, otherwise figure in good condition. Glued to wood stand.

Two quail boxes - generally good condition, one with tiny nick/scuff to tip of beak.

Glass figure of lady - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Glued to base.

Agate lotus carving - good condition, no significant damage or repairs. Couple of tiny insignificant nicks to leaves. Glued to stand.
