A Chinese blue and white porcelain jar, Kangxi period, of baluster form, painted with blossoming prunus branches on a cracked ice ground, underglaze blue double ring to base, height 35cm (repaired).

### Condition Report

1104. Hairline crack across the base. U-shaped section of neck broken out and repaired (3cm x 9cm), and a 5cm hairline running off this area and some minor chipping along the break lines. There is a 6cm x 5.5cm oval section which has been broken out of the body, this has then been amateurishly filled and overpainted, with numerous hairline cracks running off into the body from this area.
