An early 20th century Wileman & Co Foley China Spano-Lustra vase, the high-shouldered body with four loop handles to the lower half, incised with four large flowering stems above textured detail, covered in a blue and purple lustre glaze against a dark ground, black printed and incised marks to base, height 24cm.

Estimate: £50 - £80

Condition Report

In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

There are a number of places where the glaze has not been applied properly and you can see the terracotta body beneath, e.g., on and around the handles, these are a manufacturing issue and not damage. Similarly there are a number of white patches around the lower body of the vase also where the top glazes have not been applied properly during the manufacturing process.

The images on our website show these patches and missing glaze areas, they can look like damage in the images but they are not.
