**Condition Report**

In good condition overall with no restoration.

There are a few indistinct long craze lines to the glaze only noticeable on closer inspection.

There is a minor chip to the back edge of the footrim, just noticeable when the object is on a flat surface - please see image 6 on our website where it is to the left of the random blue dot which is itself a stray spot from the manufacturing process.
