### LOT 1503

A Moorcroft Pottery Pansy pattern circular bowl with pewter cover, 1920s, a band of buds to the exterior on a shaded blue to green ground, full blown blooms to the base interior against a dark blue ground, the pewter cover with a hammered finish, impressed marks to base of bowl with blue painted initials, the underside of the cover with numerals 01333, diameter 14cm.

Estimate: £150 - £200

### Condition Report

The cover fits really well and is in good condition, but there is always the possibility it is matched or the bowl never originally had a cover - particularly as the interior is so well decorated.

Overall fine crazing to the glaze and a few typical scratches mainly to the bowl interior.

There is an unsprung chip to the edge of the foot approx 1.5cm long, probably where an impact has occurred.
