### LOT 1612

A Macintyre Moorcroft Florian Ware two-handled vase, 1904-13, decorated with panels of roses and tulips against a cream ground, flanked by green glazed loop handles, brown printed factory mark to base with green painted signature and impressed shape number, height 18cm (restored).

Estimate: £60 - £100

### Condition Report

A large U-shaped section of the main body (approx one fifth) has been broken away and professionally restored back into place. The broken section includes one of the handles but this handle is itself not damaged or affected in any way. The restoration is well executed and only noticeable on closer inspection by a trained eye.

Otherwise there is typical crazing to the glaze.

There is a short vertical haircrack to the footrim which leads into a horizontal haircrack just above the footrim which runs for approx 5cm.
