A large Lucie Rie stoneware studio pottery oval dish, mid 20th century, the upper surface with a sgraffito design of fine parallel lines running lengthways across the dish, the underside with a speckled partially erupted glaze, indistinct impressed seal mark to underside, length 39cm (broken and repaired).

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

If you position the dish lengthways in front of you (so the line decoration is running vertically) and look down on it, there is a glued break running diagonally from the top right corner down towards the lower middle of the left hand side of the dish. The top right corner is missing a triangular shaped section approx 6.5cm long and alongside this is a glued triangular shaped section which is 5cm long on its longest side. At the other end of the long break line there is a small triangular shaped section missing from the rim, the longest side of this missing triangle is approx 1cm long.

There are small glaze losses and chipping along the edge of each of the missing sections and the glued repairs.
