LOT 1522

A group of Caughley porcelain printed in underglaze blue with the Fisherman pattern, circa 1779-99, comprising a pair of asparagus servers, a circular egg drainer, a leaf shaped pickle dish, a pair of butter boats and another smaller, and three scalloped rim plates, two 18.8cm diameter and one 20.3cm diameter, together with a Travellers pattern scalloped rim plate, diameter 16.5cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

One of the pair of larger butter boats has a crack to the lower handle terminal.

The leaf shaped pickle dish has two minor haircracks to the rim and a couple of minuscule nicks to the serrated rim edge.

Egg drainer has some firing cracks running between the pierced holes.

One of the asparagus servers has a small chip to one corner.

Largest Fisherman plate has some professional restoration to the rim at 9 o'clock.

One of the smaller Fisherman plates has a chip to the underside rim edge at 11 o'clock.

The remaining items in the lot are in good condition.
