A Moorcroft Pottery orange lustre glazed vase, early 20th century, impressed marks to base, height 10.3cm, together with a mixed group of mostly studio pottery, including a Mike Bishop mottled blue/green glazed mug, height 11.5cm, a Glenshee Pottery vase, height 8.5cm, a Ruthanne Tudball mug, height 10.3cm, a Leaper of Newlyn orange glazed plate, diameter 14.5cm, a Chris Otway vase, height 11cm, and an Ian Tuntigi green glazed vase with overlapping stylized leaf decoration, height 20.5cm.

Condition Report

Large circular bowl with fish on has minor glaze chip to rim.

Small blue and white vase with floral decoration has minor chip to rim.

Ribbed oatmeal glazed bowl with single line decoration is cracked.

Grey glazed pot with pale blue geometric band is missing cover.

Stem cup has firing crack to rim.

Ochre and erupted glaze mug has some glaze loss to the rim.

Tuntigi vase has two large glued chips to the neck rim.

Moorcroft vase is typically crazed with some minor surface scratches and some manufacturing blemishes to the glaze.

Otherwise items in the lot are in good condition.
