A Thuringian Plaue porcelain Meissen style coffee pot and cover, 20th century, painted with pink roses, the spout and handle with gilt edged scroll moulded detail, underglaze blue mark to base, height 28cm, together with a small group of other Continental porcelain, late 19th and 20th century, including a gilt metal mounted Rococo shaped Paris snuff box with hinged lid painted with a courting couple, length 9cm, two similar circular boxes, a drainer and a pastille burner with hinged, pierced cover, height 17cm.

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

Coffee pot - two tiny chips to inner flange where cover sits, finial of cover with minor chipping to petals of pink rose and some indistinct nicks to leaves of finial.

Paris snuff - the porcelain is in good order, the mount fittings have degraded and need attention as although the box shuts it doesn't close firmly.

Yellow circular box - in good condition overall, wear to gilding.

Box with lady to cover - light surface scratches, otherwise ok.

Box with floral garlands - gilding worn, otherwise ok.

Drainer - in good condition.

Pastille burner - some minor chipping to relief flowers, otherwise ok.
