## **LOT 1506**

A Meissen cobalt blue ground cabinet cup and saucer, early 19th century, painted with an oval panel depicting the Madonna and Child within a gilt foliate frame, the bifurcated handle formed from a pair of entwined serpents, raised on three paw feet, the saucer with matching gilt border to the rim, underglaze blue crossed swords mark and impressed numerals to base of saucer, diameter of saucer 12.8cm, height of cup 8cm (cup restored), a Sèvres style cobalt blue ground cabinet coffee can, early 19th century, painted with opposing panels of cherubs within gilt foliate and scroll framing, unmarked, height 6.8cm, a Chelsea pink, blue and gilt peacock feather design cup, a Wedgwood three colour Jasperware green ground coffee can and saucer, and a mixed group of other similar porcelain (faults and restoration throughout).

## **Condition Report**

Meissen with Madonna - cup has a U-shaped section of restoration to the top edge on the right hand side of the main panel, there is associated clear spraying to the surrounding area and over the panel, one of the feet has also been broken off and professionally restored back into position. Saucer in good condition.

Sevres style can - in good condition overall, some light surface scratches to blue ground. Beautifully painted. Chelsea cup - handle very poorly restored with subsequent losses.

Wedgwood three colour - saucer with 2 chips, handle of cup riveted and very poorly restored.

Schoelcher cup and saucer - saucer quite worn to well and rim, cup ok.

Pair pink rosebud cups and saucers - one saucer heavily crazed, other with starcrack, one cup badly chipped, other ok.

Barr cup and saucer with black classical figures - light wear but ok.

Cobalt blue ground cup and saucer with flowers - saucer cracked and crazed, wear to cup.

Limoges turquoise banded and gilt can and saucer - ok.

Grey ground floral decorated cup and saucer - both crazed, haircrack to saucer.

Two floral painted cups and saucers with green feathered rims - both saucers and one cup crazed, haircracks to saucers otherwise cups ok.

Meissen cup and saucer - saucer restored, cup generally ok.

Pair Meissen floral painted cups and saucers - 2 small nicks to rim of one saucer, cups ok.

Copeland stand - ok

Ginori small single handled dish - chip to spout.

4 small Copeland coffee cans - each quite worn and crazed, one riveted. The matching saucers - one chipped.
