

Greenwood - 'Map of the County of Sussex', engraving with hand colouring; Robert Morden - Map of Sussex, engraving with hand colouring; and a pair of maps of the Sussex coast from Littlehampton to Rye, published 1777 by J. Stoke, all within Hogarth style frames (5).
