An early 20th century Maori carved hardwood tewhatewha long-handled club, the long shaft with pointed end and projecting bladed terminal, finely carved with scrolls, length 138cm.

Condition Report

2330. Some minor scuffs and surface marks, but generally good condition. The head has a pierced hole presumably for hanging. The blade has quite a deep and dark patina, but the shaft is less patinated overall.
