A Rolex Oyster Perpetual GMT-Master stainless steel cased gentleman's bracelet wristwatch, Ref. 1675, circa 1969, with signed and jewelled 1570 caliber movement numbered 'D364147', the signed black dial with luminous hour markers, date aperture, Mercedes hands, centre seconds and arrow tipped dual time zone hand, the outer rotating blue and red 'Pepsi' bezel with Arabic numerals, numbered between the lugs '1675' and '1961959', Rolex crown to winding button, the signed case back interior numbered '1675' above 'III.68', the tapered link bracelet with signed foldover clasp, case diameter 4cm.

Condition Report

1070. The watch is in generally good but typically worn condition.

The automatic movement winds and adjust smoothly, date rolls over as it should and it is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

Case with typical surface scratches and wear.

Bezel is scratched and some fading to the red section.

Glass/crystal has surface scratches and scuffs at 12 o'clock and 3 o'clock, but no cracks or chips.

Bracelet with surface scratches and wear, clasp in working order but does not 'click' closed.

Some minor dents and misshaping to clasp top.
