A Turkish market .800 silver hunting cased keywind gentleman's pocket watch, the jewelled movement detailed 'Belenus', the enamelled dial with Turkish hour markers, gilt tughra and subsidiary seconds, the floral engraved case with pseudo English hallmarks and detailed '.800', case diameter 5cm, together with a silver half-hunting cased keywind gentleman's pocket watch, the backplate signed 'Wm Johnson Strand London', London 1851, case diameter 4.6cm, a silver keywind open faced gentleman's pocket watch and a silver lady's fob watch.

Condition Report

1101. Turkish watch - does not wind or run. Case with dents, repair and wear. Crack to dial.

Half-hunter cased watch - winds but does not run. Crack to dial and missing inner glass. Typical wear to case.

Silver gents watch - winds smoothly and is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Dial good. Wear to case.

Lady's fob watch - winds and adjusts smoothly, starts to run but is a bit sporadic. Dial ok. Missing glass. Case generally ok with typical wear.

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
