A rare late 19th century slate cased table clock with one year going movement, the 8-inch white enameled circular dial with black Roman hour numerals and detailed 'Regulator Going One Year Exad by Dent 33 Cockspur St. London', the rectangular case with plinth base, height 39cm, with pendulum.

Condition Report

1160 - The movement winds smoothly and is clearly running but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

Achille Brocot makers mark to backplate. The dial has white-filled repairs/restoration around the winding hole, aswell as some typical surface scratches, otherwise appears to be ok.

Slate case has some small chips to corners and edges but no significant damage. Bevelled glass and lacquered brass front door opens and closes tightly. Hinge is good. Brass back door also in good order and hinge is good.
