LOT 1140

A late 19th/early 20th century gilt lacquered brass cased carriage clock, the eight day movement striking hours and half hours and repeating on a gong, the cream dial with black Arabic hour numerals, the pierced and engraved gilt fretwork surround decorated with griffons and scrolling foliage, the case with reeded swing handle above fluted corner columns and bevelled glass panels, height including handle 18.8cm, with key.

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

1140 - The clock is in generally good condition, typical light surface scratches and wear to case but no significant damage, small chip to top left corner of front glass panel but no obviously apparent. Dial is in good clean condition, winds and adjusts smoothly and it is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

The strike mechanism also winds smoothly and is working but not hitting the gong correctly so would need a little attention/adjustment.
