A mid-19th century French engraved gilt lacquered brass 'one-piece' cased carriage alarm clock by Bolviller, the eight day movement striking hours and alarm on a bell, the backplate signed 'Bolviller à Paris' and numbered '65', the white enamelled dial with black Roman hour numerals and subsidiary alarm dial with Arabic numerals and signed 'Bolviller a Paris', the case with engraved foliate scrolls, swing handle and bevelled glass panels, height including handle 17.5cm (back door detached and other minor faults).

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

1150. The clock does not wind or run at present.

Dial has a faint hairline to the centre, otherwise ok.

Case with typical light wear and surface scratches, otherwise good. Glass top panel is loose. Glass front panel and one side panel with small chips to corners. Back door has one pin missing, so is detached.
