A George III japanned black and gilt cased wall clock with eight day single fusee movement, the 10½-inch black painted arch dial with gilt Roman hour numerals and inscribed 'Thwaites London' to the arch, the arched case with glazed door, height 52cm, with pendulum and winding key.

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

1171. The clock is in generally ok condition, but has restoration and alterations.

The case has been restored with overpainting and gilt.

Dial also repainted and we think the 'Thwaites London' is probably not original. Hands are fairly modern replacements. It appears to have been through some ones workshop and 'spruced up'.

The movement is pretty loose in the case to the point the hands are now detached. The seat board has some age but the blocks for that to sit on in the case are later.
