A George III mahogany longcase clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, the 12-inch painted breakarch dial with a scene of hunters and two pointers to the arch, above black Roman hour numerals, subsidiary seconds and date dials, and inscribed 'Bromley Horsham', the arched hood with brass ball and spire finials above a glazed door and fluted columns, the trunk with arched door and cut corners, on a panelled base and bracket feet, height 229cm, with pendulum and one weight (lacking one weight).

Condition Report

1197. Case in generally good order, typical nicks and splits to veneers, but very dirty and nicotine stained. Painted dial with craquelure and nicotine staining. Movement is dirty and dusty so would probably require a service to return it to working order. Please be aware, there is only one weight so it will need another weight. Pendulum is present.
