A mid-19th century Scottish mahogany longcase clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, the 14-inch painted breakarch dial with titled scene 'The Thunder Storm' to arch above black Roman hour numerals, subsidiary seconds and date dials and inscribed 'Wm Ingram Ayr', cornered with painted scenes representing the four seasons, the hood with swan neck pediment, glazed door and turned columns, above a rectangular trunk door, plain base and bracket feet, height 218cm, with pendulum and two weights.

1196. Case and movement appear to be a marriage.

Some chips and losses to veneers and mouldings on the hood. Hood needs some attention.

Dial is a bit worn and dirty.

All parts are present, but does not currently work, may require a full service/overhaul to return to good working order.
