Condition Report

1176. Cosmetically the clock is in fairly good condition, if a little dirty and dusty.

There is a vertical split to the base.

There have been alterations to the movement with it now striking on gongs rather than a bell.

The movement is dirty and we would suggest a service/overhaul to movement would be required to return it to working condition.
