A pair of Chinese famille verte export porcelain circular dishes, Kangxi period, each painted with central peony and prunus-charged vase and stand, surrounded by further precious vessels and objects, within a trellis rim divided by flower vignettes, underglaze blue artemisia leaf within double ring to base, diameters 37.1cm (restoration).

Estimate: £500 - £800

Condition Report

Both dishes broken into a number of sizable pieces and professionally restored with extensive repainting to a reasonable degree. Most of the damage to the rims but also parts of the well - particularly on one of the dishes. Both rims with fritted chipping to the whole circumference.
