A Chinese faux bois porcelain brushpot, mark of Qianlong but later, the cylindrical body painted en grisaille with a dragon amidst clouds, divided by five lines of black text and three red seals between borders of simulated wood grain, repeated to interior, underglaze blue seal mark to base, height 10cm.

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. There is some minor and light wear commensurate with age and handling, e.g., to the top rim edge, footrim and base interior. The dragon decoration displays some patchy wear. Otherwise some light surface scratches to glaze overall.
