A pair of Chinese Canton export watercolour on rice paper paintings, mid to late 19th century, each painted with butterflies, blossoming flowers and other insects, 17cm x 30cm, framed and glazed.

### Condition Report

Large pink peony to centre - tiny tear to top left corner and a couple of tiny holes amidst main picture, minor staining along left hand side, vertical striations to rice paper - otherwise good.

Other picture with blue beetle to bottom left corner - curved tear to left side by beetle, horizontal tear to right side beneath butterfly stopping just before stem, small hole to wing of largest butterfly.

Neither picture sits flat in the frame, both are slightly ruckled.
