A Chinese famille rose porcelain supper set, late Qing dynasty, comprising nine variously shaped dishes, each painted with a different figure beneath two-tone blue key fret borders, unmarked, within a square wood box, the cover carved in relief with a bat to each corner and central roundel, width 30.5cm.

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

1093 - One of the arched dishes has a small chip to one outer edge corner, otherwise each is in good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration. The gilt rims are rubbed.

The base of the box has splits to two corners and the base interior has a gap down one side.

The cover of the box has lifted slightly from its sides and is warped a little out of shape as it does not fit snugly onto the base. It has typical wear commensurate with age and handling.
