LOT 1103

A Chinese blue and white porcelain bowl, mark of Kangxi but later, of steep-sided circular form, painted to the exterior with two dragons chasing flaming pearls amidst a blue ground of vapours and wispy clouds, underglaze blue six-character mark within double ring to base, diameter 16.5cm, together with a Chinese blue and white porcelain circular bowl, Kangxi period, painted with flowers, artemisia leaf mark to base, diameter 19cm (cracked), and a Chinese famille verte porcelain circular bowl, Kangxi period, painted with lotus, precious objects and scrolling tendrils, diameter 19cm (repaired).

Estimate: £300 - £400

Condition Report

1103 - Bowl with dragons ♦ minor vertical glaze blemish to rim approx 1cm long, only noticeable on close inspection under a strong light. Light surface scratches to base interior, otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration

Bowl with flowers ♦ 2 long vertical cracks to rim which is fritted to the whole circumference.

Famille Verte bowl ♦ badly broken with riveted and glued repairs, missing two small sections out of the damaged areas. Metal edge applied to rim probably to stabilise the bowl.
