A Chinese blue and white export porcelain ginger jar, 18th/19th century, of ovoid form, painted with a repeated design of lotus and scrolling tendrils divided by shou characters, between ruyi-head and lappet borders, height 20.2cm (star crack to base), together with a carved hardwood stand.

### Condition Report

1107 - Five branch starcrack to base otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Light surface scratches to widest part of body.

Stand has some drilled holes, a small glued section to the apron and a crack to the top.
