A Sino-Tibetan amber glass bead mala court necklace, late Qing dynasty, the one hundred and eight amber glass spherical beads with mottled green jade glass spacer beads, the front hung with beaded tassels and gilt metal mounted glass pendant drops, total length excluding tassel pendants approx 154cm, housed within a red painted card circular box and cover with silk lining.

Estimate: £250 - £350

Condition Report

1112 - Missing at least one pendant drop section as the necklace is not symmetrical. Otherwise in good condition overall with no significant damage or repairs.

The card box is tired with significant overall losses to the painted detail. The silk lining is faded and partly detached from the inner sides of the box.

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
