A pair of Japanese cloisonné jardinières, Meiji period, each of squat globular form, decorated with a sparrow flying above flowers on a primrose yellow ground, height 11cm, together with a larger Japanese cloisonné jardinière, Meiji period, decorated with opposing panels of butterflies, birds and flowers, height 23.5cm (all with faults).

Condition Report

1120 - Largest jardiniere ♦ hairlines visible to the main panels, primarily near the top of each ♦ please see the images on our website. Footrim slightly misshapen. Crack to interior around circumference of outer footrim. First of pair ♦ circular area of loss to one of the red flowers approximately 1cm diameter, otherwise with lots of hairlines primarily visible around the shoulders of the jardiniere.

Second of pair ♦ bruised area of loss to pale ground above one of the white flowers approximately 0.5cm diameter, otherwise lots of hairlines primarily visible around the shoulders of the jardiniere.
