A Chinese porcelain snuff bottle, early 20th century, the cylindrical body painted with iron red Buddhistic lion and cub, with silver mounted rim and stopper, height 8.5cm, together with two Chinese glass snuff bottles and stoppers and a Japanese cloisonné diminutive vase, Meiji period, decorated with wisteria on a pale blue foil backed ground, height 6.3cm, with wood stand.

Condition Report

Iron red Buddhistic lion bottle - 3 small haircracks, all in the same area, to edge of foot, which is also fritted to its whole circumference, please see image 12 on our website. Tiny dent to pierced stopper. Enamels good.

White glass bottle - 2 small chips to top rim edge and tiny nick to fishing line on one side of bottle.

Dark glass bottle - in good condition with no damage or repairs.

Cloisonne vase - vertical cracks around foot of vase and bruises to shoulders - see images on our website using the zoom function.
