Condition Report

1241 - The Chinese hardwood frame is in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical scuffs, scratches and minor nicks but nothing significant. It is a bit dusty and dirty so would benefit from a clean. Four drill holes to top corners where brackets were attached. One slotted fixing to back broken and missing. As you can see tape has been used to secure the back panel which is currently fixed securely. Back panel has a split.

The panel has some light spotting and staining. Few scratches around edges and some slight fraying to edges. Panel is a little rippled where it isn't secured tightly.
