### Condition Report

425. Generally each body in good condition with fairly crisp decoration. Typical minor surface scratches and wear. All hallmarks are worn.

Teapot - lid is bent so does not sit properly. Handle is secure. Underside has numerous small dents.

Milk jug and sugar bowl - both with typical light surface scratches and wear. Both with small dents to undersides and feet pushed up into body on both pieces.
