LOT 2001

An early 18th century Chinese export lacquer collector's cabinet, raised on a later matched stand, the cabinet with overall engraved brass mounts and with overall landscape scenes of raised gilt lacquer, the interior fitted with an arrangement of drawers, height 170cm, width 109cm, depth 56cm (faults).

Estimate: £1,500 - £2,500

Condition Report

2001. Overall surface wear and some loss to the decoration, with much loss to the surface of the top.

Some of the hinges are a bit loose and the decoration escutcheon mount is detached.

Vertical cracks to the front of both doors as well as cracks around the edges of the doors.

Surface appears to have an overall yellowed varnish.

Interior handles appear to have been changed at some point in its life and there has been a ball catch fitted to the top edge of the right door.

Overall scuffs, marks and areas of slight loss to interior.

The base is certainly not period and dates from around 1900.
