A William IV silver pair cased keywind open-faced gentleman's pocket watch, the gilt fusee movement with verge escapement, signed 'C. Lasseter Steyning', the enamelled dial with black Roman hour numerals, the outer case containing watch papers for 'C. Atkins of Arundel', London 1832, outer case diameter 5.5cm, together with a later silver pair cased gentleman's pocket watch, the movement signed 'J. Cartwright Horncastle', the case back detailed 'Dench Horsham', London 1856, outer case diameter 5.4cm.

Condition Report

1097. Lasseter watch - repair to chip around centre of dial and hairline crack. Glass/crystal is chipped. Case back with typical scratches and wear. Engraved name 'William Daughtry' around the edge and 'Harry Cutler' to centre.

Movement winds smoothly and it is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Later plated bow surmount.

Outer case with typical wear and scratches. Few minor dents and release button missing.

Cartwright watch - dial cracked, glass badly scratched.

Winds smoothly and it is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

Case with typical surface scratches.

Outer case with numerous dents and split at 6 o'clock.

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
