LOT 1145

A late 19th/early 20th century gilt lacquered brass cased carriage clock, the eight day movement striking hours and half hours and repeating on a gong, the cream dial with black Arabic hour numerals, the pierced and engraved gilt fretwork surround decorated with griffons and scrolling foliage, the case with reeded swing handle above fluted corner columns and bevelled glass panels, height including handle 18.8cm, with key.

Estimate: £180 - £240

Condition Report

1145. Generally good condition, typical light surface scratches and wear, but no significant damage. Small chip to one top corner of each front and back glass panel.

Dial in good clean condition.

Both trains wind smoothly and the clock is currently running but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

Strike mechanism and repeat appears to be working, but the hammer is not making contact with the gong so would require some attention.

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
