A late Victorian brass skeleton clock with eight day single fusee movement with passing strike on a bell, the silvered skeletonized chapter ring with black Roman hour numerals beneath a small silvered plaque, signed 'D. Elwig St. Ives', the pierced scroll frame with bell surmount, on turned feet, with white marble oval base and glass dome, total height 47cm, with pendulum.

### Condition Report

1126. Generally good condition with typical light surface scratches and wear. No significant damage or repairs. Typical wear to silvered dial.
