### LOT 1113

A late 19th century French brass cased carriage clock by E. Maurice & Co, of large proportions, with eight day movement striking and repeating on a gong, the backplate stamped 'E.M & Co', the silvered dial with black Arabic hour numerals framing a gilt foliate boss, the Corinthian column case with swing handle and bevelled glass panels, height 19cm, with travelling case and winding key.

### Condition Report

1113. Clock in generally good condition, typical surface scratches and wear. Glass panels in good condition. Silvered dial with typical surface scratches and a little dirty.

Both trains wind smoothly, strike mechanism and push repeat in working order, and it is currently running and keeping time, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch and this clock may require a service for everything to work fully and consistently.
