An early 19th century brass inlaid mahogany drop dial wall clock with eight day twin fusee movement striking on a bell, the repainted 12-inch convex dial with black Roman hour numerals and detailed 'De La Salle Cannon Street London', within a gadrooned circular surround, the case and apron with brass inlaid decoration, case diameter 35.5cm, height 63cm, with pendulum and case keys.

Condition Report

1144. Generally in good restored condition.

Case with small section of moulding missing to side, otherwise generally good condition with typical veneer splits, scuffs and scratches. Minor nicks to surround. Glass front and hinge good. Dial repainted.

Winds and adjusts smoothly, strike mechanism in good working order, and it is currently running but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.
