A late Victorian brass lantern clock with eight day twin fusee movement striking hours and quarters on a bell, the circular chapter ring with black Roman hour numerals framing a central mock alarm disc and inscribed 'Thomas Wheeler Near The French Church In Londini', the 17th century style case of typical form with domed bell surmount and turned finials above pierced and engraved fret panels, the turned corner columns with hinged side and back panels, on turned ball feet, height 39.5cm, with pendulum.
