A Heuer Monaco Chronograph stainless steel gentleman's bracelet wristwatch, Ref. 73633, circa early 1970s, with manual wind Valjoux 7736 caliber movement, the signed grey dial with three black subsidiary dials, silvered baton hour markers and red centre stop seconds hand, the case back with Heuer paper label, detailed '73633' above '166512', the same numbers detailed between the lugs, the tapered link bracelet with signed foldover clasp, case width 4cm, with Heuer warranty booklet and red plastic hang tag.

Condition Report

1070. The watch is in generally good clean condition, with only very minor typical light surface scratches and wear to case, crystal/glass and bracelet.

Dial is in good clean order.

Bracelet is good and clasp in good working order.

Winds and adjusts smoothly and is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

Please note, the chrono feature works with start, stop and reset buttons all working as they should, but the second hand stops/sticks after 12 seconds so would require attention.

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
