A late Victorian gold, sapphire and rose cut diamond three stone ring, claw set with the rose cut diamond between two smaller cushion shaped sapphires and split shoulders, detailed '18', weight 3.2g, ring size approx O, with a case, together with an unmounted loose colourless gem.

Estimate: £250 - £350

Condition Report

Ring - has inscription to the interior of shank and dated '1899'. Rose diamond has a few inclusions, particularly to one side, noticeable without magnification, as well as a number of nibbles to the girdle.

Claws all intact and no obvious signs of significant wear to the sides or shank. Sapphires fairly included stones but well matched for colour.

Colourless gemstone - is a colourless topaz, some nibbles to facet edges

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
