### Condition Report

There is the slightest of dents to the interior of the bowl which is evident on the exterior approximately one third of the way up from the foot rim.

Some typical light scratching to the interior/exterior.

Decoration to rim is still fairly crisp.

Makers mark is rubbed slightly, the other hallmarks are clear.
