A pair of mid-20th century French silver mounted rectangular cut glass bottles and stoppers, each fitted with a silver collar and screw cover, monogram engraved, height 16.8cm, within a brown leather fitted twin-section case, detailed 'Hermès... Paris'.

Condition Report

378. One decanter has a small chip to the base edge and a small chip to the underside edge of the stopper. The other decanter has a minor nick to the top side edge.

The leather case is monogram impressed to the top, it has some minor wear to the corners and a few surface scratches, there is a minor tear to the hinge at both ends, the handle is stiff and dry with some splits and cracks.

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
