A pair of William IV Irish silver goblets, each 'U' shaped body crest engraved with a griffin above a crown opposing a dove and cross, on a tapering stem and circular foot with graduated band, Dublin 1832 by Richard Sawyer, total weight 402.3g, height 15.7cm.

Estimate: £1,000 - £1,500

Condition Report

First goblet - a dent and small split to the foot near the stem, a few small dents to the bowl, some splitting to the rim of the bowl which has had three or four small repairs on the interior.

Second goblet - a few dents to the exterior of the bowl, otherwise in better overall condition.

Some rubbing to the hallmarks on both goblets.
