Condition Report

Star hairline crack to the dial.

Hinges are working, though there is movement to one when the stand is folded flat against the wood, would advise handling with care to avoid damage.

Enamel is in very good condition, no obvious damage seen.

The clock is ticking having tried the key, but we cannot guarantee the clock is working.

Hallmarks fairly crisp.
